The EU in Its International Institutional Relationships

This workshop is the result of a scientific research activity that the trainees carried out in two stages during the course of International Organization.

In a first phase, the trainees were asked to apply the general 'categories' (founding treaty, members, organs, competences, acts, etc.) to an international organization, freely chosen by each of them. The aim was to identify the type of international organization and to verify the organization's capacity to establish international relations with other States, international organizations and bodies.

In the second phase, the trainees were asked to investigate the relationship between their organization and the European Union in order to verify the Union's capacity to project its values and aims in external relations.
