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2024 CHAIR COURSE

Enlargement, Values and Integration into the EU

Objectives: The course aims to provide an in-depth and detailed understanding of the European integration process through the lens of enlargement and the development of the Union's identity based on the founding values. The course is divided into modules that will help trainees understand the internal and external challenges of enlargement, the benefits of closer integration, and the necessary reforms for the Union.

Activities: The Course will be delivered through lectures, training seminars, workshops, simulations, and group projects that combine theoretical-practical and problem-solving approach.

It will take place three times per week from April to June, where the two final conferences will be held in Belgrade, Serbia (30 May) and Salerno, Italy (4 June).

Workshops: Trainees will work in small groups under the supervision of the Chair Holder and with the help of Tutors to develop papers in the form of questions and possible solutions. These will include key points for discussion and development at the conference of 4 June. This will assess public perception of the European Union and opportunities for integration. The authors of the best papers will be asked to revise them into a scientific publication as an OER.

Seminars and intensive lectures, also in the framework of the EUVALWEB Legal Observatory, will be organized and held by the Team Chair and international and national legal experts. These will be open for public participation.
