Methology of the Conference

This Conference concludes the activities of the Chair Course 'Enlargement, Values and Integration into the EU' of the EUVALWEB Jean Monnet Chair, that were carried out in 4 modules respectively dedicated to: 1) Enlargement as a Policy of the European Integration Process; 2) Enlargement as a Policy to Promote Peace and Security in Europe; 3) Enlargement and Treaty Revision; 4) Enlargement and the Future of the European Union: Values, Democratic Dimensions, and European Parliament Elections..

During these modules, 4 workshops were held in which the participants were divided into 5 working groups, coordinated by the Chair holder with the support of the tutors. Using a critical method of reading and comparing norms and documents, the participants were asked to answer a series of questions both on their knowledge of European Union Law and on their "belonging" to the Union. At the end, they were asked to submit questions that were better explored in the presentation of short papers forming the debate of the conference.
