2023 CHAIR COURSE

Enlargement Policy, EU Values and the Western Balkans' Accession

Objectives: EUVALWEB Chair Course aims at providing in-depth and detailed knowledge of the European integration process and the construction of the Union's identity based on its founding values. It is divided into modules as specified below and will enable trainees to familiarize themselves with the internal and external challenges posed by the various enlargement processes and to understand the benefits of 'ever closer integration among the peoples of Europe'.

Activities: the Course will

take place three times a week of 4 hours each, from March to May. It will be held by the Chair Holder as a stand-alone course, but associated with the other courses, held by the same Chair Holder (EU Law and EU Migration Law).

Workshop: Small groups of Trainees under the supervision of the Chair Holder and with the support of Tutors, will carry out interactive workshops for the elaboration of papers. The authors of the best papers will be invited to rework them into a scientific article for publication as an OER.
